



Recreation Fund Grant Guidelines

Purpose:

The Steamboat Ski & Resort Corporation's Recreation Fund provides charitable support for above ground capital recreational projects and facilities in Routt County, Colorado. Recreation is one of the five key areas of interest of the Yampa Valley Community Foundation.

Granting Criteria:

- The nonprofit recreation project is:
 - Located within Routt County
 - Visible and accessible to residents and visitors alike
 - Contributes to the quality of life in Routt County
- Preference is given to tangible projects that result in a completed project or facility within one year.
- Proposed projects must have written approval from controlling entity, i.e. city or county governments, or school districts.
- The Steamboat Ski and Resort Corporation's Recreation Fund is acknowledged in signage and publicity
- Projects to maintain or rehabilitate existing facilities will not be funded
- Proposals for general operating funds, debt reduction, endowments, political or religious purposes will not be considered.

Process for Application:

Proposals are accepted year-round and reviewed semi-annually. 2008 deadlines are March 17th (notification June 15th) and September 15th (notification December 15th).

The current proposal form must be used and included all of the requested information. Please contact the YVCF staff with any questions regarding the application form or grant criteria.

Review Committee:

In addition to the YVCF Grants and Initiatives Committee, grant proposals may also be shared with individuals who have donor advised funds at YVCF and others who have a charitable interest in supporting worthy recreational projects.
